After 28 years as Secretary-General at your service, a period in which FISU has grown from a modest sports federation with hardly any financial means to a reputable international organisation with a world wide sports and educational programme and with a stable financial basis, I have decided to run for the FISU Presidency.

My candidature is the manifestation of my sincere wish to continue my work for the International University Sports Movement and to serve you as your representative.

Since my sports career in Belgium where I became runner up with my team in the Belgian Basketball Championship, I also had the honour to be selected for the Belgian basketball team participating at the Universiades of Budapest (1965) and Tokyo (1967), carrying the Belgian flag in the Athletes' parade at the Opening Ceremony of the Budapest Universiade.

After my active basketball career, I became involved in the Olympic movement and served as the official secretary of the Belgian delegation at the 1972 Munich Olympic Games, the 1976 Montreal Olympic Games and the 1980 Moscow Olympic Games. In 1985 I became a member of the Belgian Olympic Committee.

I have been a member of the FISU Executive Committee since 1973, Secretary-General since 1979, Secretary-General and President of the Belgian University Sports Federation since 1973 and 1983 respectively. Thus, I hereby am more than confident that with the vast experience of almost 30 years in sport in general and in International University Sport in particular you will consider me an appropriate candidate for the highest office of FISU leading our beloved organisation to further horizons.

I therefore entrust my future involvement in the International University Sports Movement in your hands and am convinced that you will make the right choice at the General Assembly in Bangkok next August.
